#### **Psalm 33**

1. Rejoice in the LORD, O you righteous! For praise from the upright is beautiful.
2. Praise the LORD with the harp; Make melody to Him with an instrument of ten strings.
3. Sing to Him a new song; Play skillfully with a shout of joy.
4. For the word of the LORD is right, And all His work is done in truth.
5. He loves righteousness and justice; The earth is full of the goodness of the LORD.
6. By the word of the LORD the heavens were made, And all the host of them by the breath of His mouth.
7. He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap; He lays up the deep in storehouses.
8. Let all the earth fear the LORD; Let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him.
9. For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast.
10. The LORD brings the counsel of the nations to nothing; He makes the plans of the peoples of no effect.
11. The counsel of the LORD stands forever, The plans of His heart to all generations.
12. Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD, The people He has chosen as His own inheritance.
13. The LORD looks from heaven; He sees all the sons of men.
14. From the place of His dwelling He looks On all the inhabitants of the earth;
15. He fashions their hearts individually; He considers all their works.
16. No king is saved by the multitude of an army; A mighty man is not delivered by great strength.
17. A horse is a vain hope for safety; Neither shall it deliver any by its great strength.

18. Behold, the eye of the LORD is on those who fear Him, On those who hope in His mercy,  
19. To deliver their soul from death, And to keep them alive in famine.  
20. Our soul waits for the LORD; He is our help and our shield.  
21. For our heart shall rejoice in Him, Because we have trusted in His holy name.  
22. Let Your mercy, O LORD, be upon us, Just as we hope in You.

**Psalm 34**

23. I will bless the LORD at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.  
24. My soul shall make its boast in the LORD; The humble shall hear of it and be glad.  
25. Oh, magnify the LORD with me, And let us exalt His name together.  
26. I sought the LORD, and He heard me, And delivered me from all my fears.  
27. They looked to Him and were radiant, And their faces were not ashamed.  
28. This poor man cried out, and the LORD heard him, And saved him out of all his troubles.  
29. The angel of the LORD encamps all around those who fear Him, And delivers them.  
30. Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good; Blessed is the man who trusts in Him!  
31. Oh, fear the LORD, you His saints! There is no want to those who fear Him.  
32. The young lions lack and suffer hunger; But those who seek the LORD shall not lack any good thing.  
33. Come, you children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the LORD.  
34. Who is the man who desires life, And loves many days, that he may see good?  
35. Keep your tongue from evil, And your lips from speaking deceit.  
36. Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it.  
37. The eyes of the LORD are on the righteous, And His ears are open to their cry.  
38. The face of the LORD is against those who do evil, To cut off the remembrance of them from the earth.  
39. The righteous cry out, and the LORD hears, And delivers them out of all their troubles.  
40. The LORD is near to those who have a broken heart, And saves such as have a contrite spirit.  
41. Many are the afflictions of the righteous, But the LORD delivers him out of them all.

42. He guards all his bones; Not one of them is broken.

43. Evil shall slay the wicked, And those who hate the righteous shall be condemned.

44. The LORD redeems the soul of His servants, And none of those who trust in Him shall be condemned.

**Psalm 71**

45. In You, O LORD, I put my trust; Let me never be put to shame.

46. Deliver me in Your righteousness, and cause me to escape; Incline Your ear to me, and save me.

47. Be my strong refuge, To which I may resort continually; You have given the commandment to save me, For You are my rock and my fortress.

48. Deliver me, O my God, out of the hand of the wicked, Out of the hand of the unrighteous and cruel man.

49. For You are my hope, O Lord GOD; You are my trust from my youth.

50. By You I have been upheld from birth; You are He who took me out of my mother's womb. My praise shall be continually of You.

51. I have become as a wonder to many, But You are my strong refuge.

52. Let my mouth be filled with Your praise And with Your glory all the day.

53. Do not cast me off in the time of old age; Do not forsake me when my strength fails.

54. For my enemies speak against me; And those who lie in wait for my life take counsel together,

55. Saying, "God has forsaken him; Pursue and take him, for there is none to deliver him."

56. O God, do not be far from me; O my God, make haste to help me!

57. Let them be confounded and consumed Who are adversaries of my life; Let them be covered with reproach and dishonor Who seek my hurt.

58. But I will hope continually, And will praise You yet more and more.

59. My mouth shall tell of Your righteousness And Your salvation all the day, For I do not know their limits.

60. I will go in the strength of the Lord GOD; I will make mention of Your righteousness, of Yours only.

61. O God, You have taught me from my youth; And to this day I declare Your wondrous works.

62. Now also when I am old and gray headed, O God, do not forsake me, Until I declare Your strength to this generation, Your power to everyone who is to come.

63. Also Your righteousness, O God, is very high, You who have done great things; O God, who is like You?

64. You, who have shown me great and severe troubles, Shall revive me again, And bring me up again from the depths of the earth.

65. You shall increase my greatness, And comfort me on every side.

66. Also with the lute I will praise You— And Your faithfulness, O my God! To You I will sing with the harp, O Holy One of Israel.

67. My lips shall greatly rejoice when I sing to You, And my soul, which You have redeemed.

68. My tongue also shall talk of Your righteousness all the day long; For they are confounded, For they are brought to shame Who seek my hurt.
